



SFA Knowledge Workbooks

Knowledge Workbooks act as a central source of information for students in lessons that contain the phases of learning. Each workbook provides every student with the challenging knowledge they are entitled to, removing low level learning via note taking, and puts retrieval, knowledge and testing at the heart of their learning. This applies to all subjects other than Key Stage 3 and 4 Maths whereby students create their own knowledge exercise books.

What a Knowledge Workbook includes

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- A cover page with subject and topic introductions
- A Knowledge Organiser for the topic that answers Big/Small questions and links into each lesson
- A series of lessons that follow the 7 phases of learning; 1. Revisiting, 2. Title/Big Small questions/Keywords, 3. Knowledge, 4. Consolidation, 5. Application, 6. Testing, 7. Homework
- A self-assessment checklist for students to self-reflect, identify strengths and weaknesses and narrow their gaps in knowledge.
