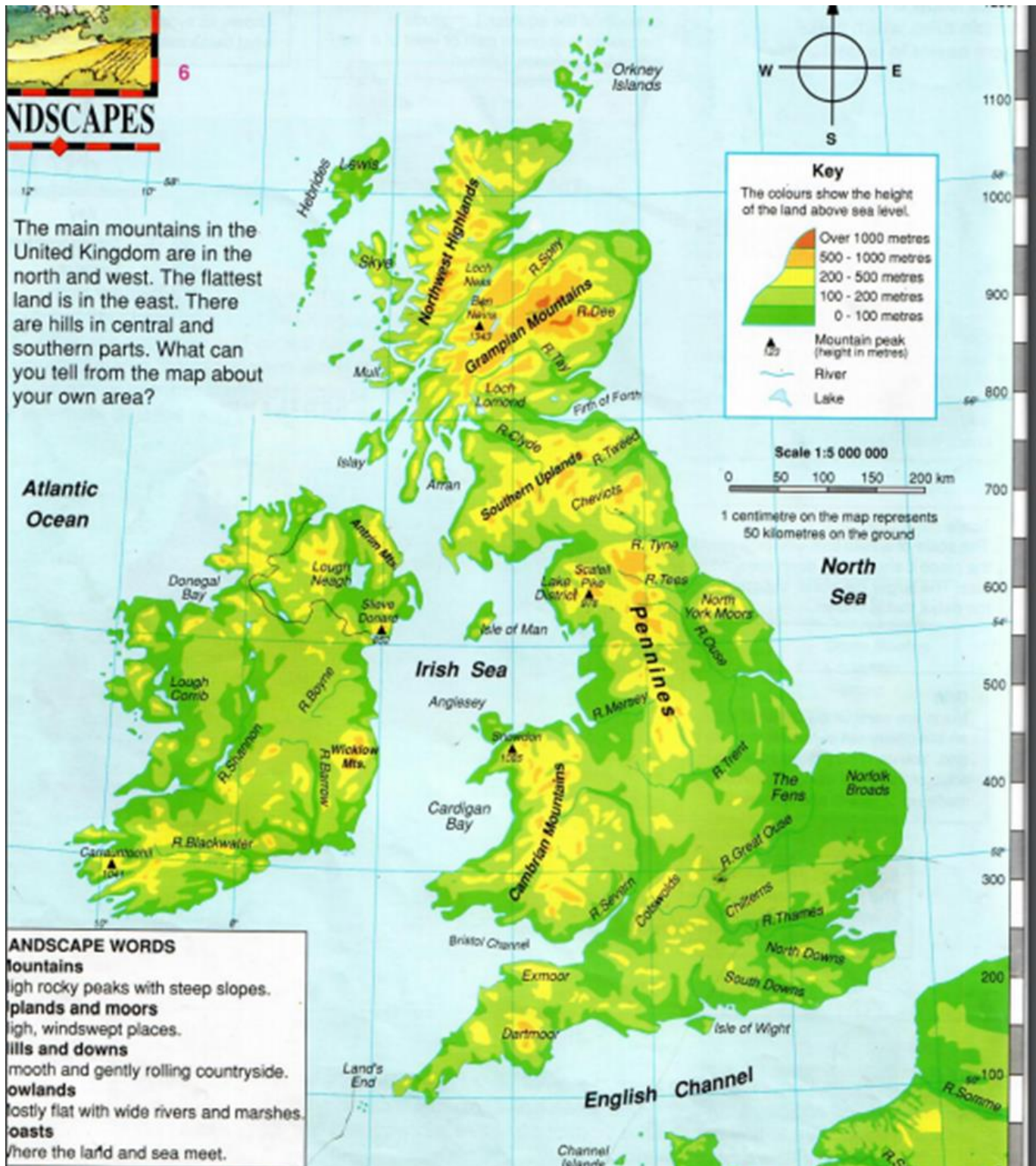

## **Knowledge**

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, commonly known as the United Kingdom (U.K. or UK) is a sovereign country located off the northwestern coast of the European mainland. The United Kingdom includes the island of Great Britain, the northeastern part of the island of Ireland, and many smaller islands. Northern Ireland is the only part of the United Kingdom that shares a land border with another sovereign state, the Republic of Ireland. Apart from this land border, the United Kingdom is surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean, with the North Sea to the east, the English Channel to the south and the Irish Sea to the south-west, giving it the 12th-longest coastline in the world. The United Kingdom was home to an estimated 66.0 million inhabitants in 2017.

Apart from England, the nations have their own devolved governments, each with varying powers. The nearby Isle of Man, Guernsey and Jersey are not part of the UK, being Crown dependencies with the British Government responsible for defence and international representation. The medieval conquest of Wales by the Kingdom of England, followed by the union between England and Scotland in 1707 to form the Kingdom of Great Britain, and the union in 1801 of Great Britain with the Kingdom of Ireland created the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland. Five-sixths of Ireland seceded from the UK in 1922, leaving the present formulation of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Great Britain therefore refers to the largest island containing England, Scotland and Wales.

The United Kingdom, on the other hand, is purely a political term: it's the independent country that encompasses all of Great Britain and the region now called Northern Ireland.

The British Isles describes the islands of Great Britain and Ireland. It includes the countries of the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland.

### Knowledge

- The Uk is 81<sup>st</sup> out of 195 countries in terms of it's area.
- The population is equivalent to 0.87% of the total world population.
- The U.K. ranks number 21 in the list of countries by population.
- This means that we are a **densely** populated country.
- Canada is 2<sup>nd</sup> in terms of it's area and number 35 in terms of it's population!
- This means that Canada is a **sparsely** populated country.
