Year 13 Results Day

Results Day for Year 13 will be hosted at St Francis of Assisi on Tuesday 10th August. This is considerably earlier than in previous years. Despite the likely relaxation of Covid restrictions we are keen to provide a safe experience for students and staff when collecting results and as a result arrangements will differ from a 'normal' year.

Below you will find information regarding the organisation of the day and we ask parents and students to take careful note of the arrangements. Information about how results have been calculated and the appeals process should you be unhappy with the process can be found on the school website.

GCE Results Day for Year 13 is on Tuesday 10th August 2020

If students are not available to collect results on the 10th August they should provide a stamped, self-addressed envelope so that results can be posted home. Due to the continuing medical climate we will not be allowing people to collect results on behalf of students.

Only Year 13 students will be allowed into the school building to collect results. Should parents/ carers wish to accompany students then I ask that you remain outside of the Green exterior gates, unless you drive on to the school site where I ask that you remain in your vehicle. Please note, that parking will be limited to certain car parks so fewer spaces will be available. All of this is to limit the number of people that staff and Y13s come into contact with.

Results will be given out in the New Hall and students will be asked to come at specific times. Once again, the aim is to limit the number of contacts.

The school site will be open at 9:00am

Students applying for Higher Education must check the UCAS website before coming into school. Information from UCAS will be available from 8.30am.

In order to give all students, the required support we ask that students follow the timetable below:
