What do you do in your job?

I am a Strategic Projects Manager for Taylor Wimpey, working within the Strategic Land function. Strategic land look to source and acquire longer term strategic sites which don't have the benefit of any existing planning permissions to serve the company. We then (as a department) promote these sites through the planning process in order to obtain a planning permission for residentially led schemes.

Most of the sites we look at are larger scale opportunities, with a mixture of commercial, retail, and residential uses.

How did you get to where you are?

I studied Geography, Physics, Chemistry and Biology at AS/A-Level before attending the University of the West of England to study Urban and Regional Planning. After graduating in 2018 I joined the Taylor Wimpey Strategic Land Graduate Scheme.
