

SFA Homework Strategy

We believe in the importance of all students completing weekly homework to continuously retrieve and consolidate prior and current learning. For most subjects, homework is paper based for students to develop pride in their work, and the opportunity for them to regularly reflect and assess the quality of their work in class.

Please see further details below:

- Homework is set weekly by all subjects on Class charts as per the SFA Homework Schedule. Homework is bi-weekly in KS3 Music, IT and Art.
- Homework will involve students reading and answering questions/activities that relate to prior or current learning.
- The minimum weekly expectation per subject includes 10 marks (KS3), 12- 20 marks (KS4), 20- 30 marks (KS5)
- The approximate weekly amount of time per subject for completion includes 30 mins (KS3), 45mins core subjects (KS3), 1 hour (KS4 all subjects), 4 hours (KS5 all subjects).
- Homework completion is checked by the class teacher during the lesson it is due
 week. Students will be provided with a WAGOLL/mark scheme to assess their work
 and make improvements whilst the teacher circulates the room to check the quality of
 work completed.
- Non completion or poor-quality homework will lead to a homework detention being issued by the class teacher.
- Homework club is on daily after school to support students with their homework completion which is open to all students.
